Greetings,

I hope this message finds you well. With the arrival of spring, Council and staff have many projects underway, along with several important initiatives nearing completion.

Council has recently completed a new Fireworks Policy. A Trees on Boulevards Policy is also close to being finalized and the current Nuisance Abatement Bylaw is being reviewed as part of ongoing efforts to modernize outdated bylaws, ensuring they better reflect the needs of our community today.

Campground bookings will soon be available online through LetsCamp.ca. This will streamline the reservation process, save staff time, and make it easier for users to secure their sites.

The Town of Burstall will receive its second installment for 2025-2026 of the Canada Community Building Fund in the amount of \$9603.60. This funding supports economic growth, environmental sustainability and strong communities.

Repairs to the water tank to address leaks are scheduled for early May, continuing for approx. 10 days to two weeks. Residents are asked to watch for notices in April regarding specific water restrictions for that time period.

Residents are encouraged to vote in the upcoming by-election for one Councillor position. The advance poll will be held on March 31 from 1:00pm – 4:00pm and Election Day April 8 from 9:00am – 8:00pm at the Community Centre.
